Apartment Search & Managing Your Housing Choice Voucher

- You have sixty (60) days to look for an apartment.
- Your Voucher will expire at the end of the sixty (60) days, unless you return a completed Request for Tenancy Approval form (inspection form).
- Manchester Housing and Redevelopment Authority (MHRA) normally grants one (1) sixty (60 day) extension. Reasonable Accommodation (for an additional sixty (60) day extension) must be requested and verified.
- Once the Request for Tenancy Approval has been received (inspection form), the Housing Choice Voucher expiration date is placed on hold.
- You will be notified if the apartment you choose passed or failed the required inspection.
- To show you are actively looking for an apartment, you **MUST** list on the enclosed Apartment Log, the apartments you have called about and/or viewed.

Providing Information to Landlords

- Most information you provide to the Manchester Housing and Redevelopment Authority is confidential, however, the Authority may advise prospective landlords of your current and/or former landlords and addresses, if asked.

Apartment Listings

- Manchester Housing and Redevelopment Authority maintains information provided by landlords concerning available apartments.
