Earning by Learning Program

For elementary and high school students who live in MHRA public housing or are assisted through MHRA's Section 8 Housing Choice Voucher program, the MHRA subsidiary Manchester Housing and Redevelopment Foundation has established a program designed to keep kids in school and encourage academic success.

Students in elementary, middle and high school can earn **\$5** for every "A" grade they receive. Upon graduation from high school, the total amount earned throughout their academic career will be paid out to the graduate to help (we hope) pay for things like college tuition and books, transportation, and work clothes although there are no restrictions on how the money may be spent. MHRA will only credit accounts for grades provided on an annual basis and cannot retroactively give credit for previous years' grades. If your child is graduating, please send a copy of their diploma and their last report cards to us.

Student accounts will only be credited for the current academic year and academic year immediately preceding this year. No retroactive adjustments will be made.
